School Improvement Goals

Little Oak Middle will:

- Increase the percentage of students achieving Mastery and above in Math on LEAP 2025
 - 4th- 61% to 66%
 - 5th- 44% to 61%
- Increase the percentage of students achieving Mastery and above in Social Studies on LEAP 2025
 - 4th- 40% to 45%
 - 5th- 35% to 45%
 - 6th- 39% to 45%
- Increase the total index points for Learners with Disabilities by 3 or more points on LEAP 2025
 - ELA- 48.7 to 51.7 index points
 - Math- 43.4 to 46.4 index points
- Increase the total index points for English Language Learners by 3 or more points on LEAP 2025
 - ELA- 55.7 to 58.7 index points
 - Math- 42.6 to 45.6 index points
